

Microdose Leuprolide

1 0.2ml of microdose leuprolide will provide 40 mcg of leuprolide. The vial has a vial access device attached to the top of the vial. **Do Not Remove this device.** In addition to the microdose leuprolide you will also have a prescription for 1 ml syringes and 27 Gauge ½ inch needles. Both will be labeled separately.

1. Place vial on table as pictured to the right.
2. Swab top of adaptor (blue dot) with alcohol swab.
3. Attach 1ml syringe to top of adapter by twisting syringe onto adapter (note blue dot is on a spring and will recess as syringe is attached)
4. After syringe attached turn vial, adaptor, and syringe upside down. See fig. 2
5. Withdrawn 0.2 ml. Remove air bubbles by moving plunger up and down and/or flicking the syringe to have air bubble rise to top.
6. When dose has been measured to 0.2 ml. Return vial to upright position on table.
7. Remove the syringe from vial by unscrewing the syringe from the adaptor.
8. Attach at 27g ½ inch needle to syringe. Fig 3
9. Inject subcutaneously as directed
